1. The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has signed a loan agreement with the OPEC Fund for International Development (OFID) towards the cost of the Colombo National Highways Project carried out by the Miscellaneous Foreign Aided Projects (MFAP) Division. Part of the loan balance will be used for payments under the contract named above.

The Road Development Authority (“the Employer”) now invites separate sealed bid from eligible bidders for the Improvement and Rehabilitation of B 367 Piliyandala –Maharagama Road Section from (3+700 km – 5+700 km)

2. The construction duration for the package is 15 months.

The International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure with post qualification.

3. Eligible bidders must meet the following general & specific criteria:

- (i) Pending Litigation shall not represent more than 50% of the bidder’s net worth
- (ii) The bidders net worth within last 5 years shall be positive
- (iii) General experience in construction contracts within last five years
- (iv) Average annual construction turnover (AACT) within last 3 years, financial resources, and specific construction experience within last 5 yrs as given in the table below.
