1. Further to the Pre-Bid Notice published on 24th March 2024, Road Development Authority (“the Employer”) under the Ministry of Transport and Highways of the Government of Sri Lanka now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the following contract package.

2. Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding via Single Stage – Two Envelope method, for implementation, operation and maintenance of the electronic toll collection system on Build, Own and Operate (BOO) basis.
3. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the bidding document may participate in this bidding:
 - a. Pending Litigation shall not represent more than 50% of the bidder’s net worth.
 - b. The bidders’ net worth for any 5 years within the period from 2016 to 2022 shall be positive.

- c. Average annual turnover (AAT) for any 5 years within the period from 2016 to 2022, financial resources, similar contract experience within the period from 2016 to 2022 and experience in key activities as given in the table below.

- Pay a non-refundable fee of Sri Lankan Rupees [SLR] 250,000.00 [Including VAT] by cash in respect of the bidding document, at the address in 4. above.
- One hard copy and a soft copy [in a compact disk] of the bidding document will be issued on the normal working days from **9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** at the address in 4 above, from **29th April 2024** onwards.

- Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka prevailing on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.
- The Technical Proposal and the Financial Proposals shall be in separate envelopes and submitted together in a sealed container.

The Bids will be opened promptly after the deadline for bid submission in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **13th May 2024 at 10:00 a.m.** at the office of the Project Director at the address in 4 above. The meeting may be held on a virtual platform and the link will be provided to the interested bidders. Bidders may make their own arrangements to conduct site visits. Any recommendation letters will be issued by the Employer to facilitate site visits.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids, and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
